Establishment of Corpus Fund, Faculty Development Fund, Equipment Replacement Fund and Maintenance Fund are essential to ensure that the developmental activities continue beyond the Project period (5 years). It is, therefore, all project institutions established the Four Funds. The purpose of these Funds is to ensure sustainability of the reform process beyond the Project Period. Sources could be a definite percentage of fee collection from students, donations from alumni and charitable organizations, IRG including commercial use of

facilities, consultancy earnings (institutional share), and matching Grants from Government/management on IRG etc.

#### C. Utilization guidelines

#### 1. Appointment of Contract Staff

Permission is granted for the appointment of Clerk cum Junior Accountant on contract basis (as per G.O (Rt) No. 1578/2017 dated 25/8/2017) for the continuation of TEQIP II activities using four funds. The salary of Rs. 12,000/- month can be fixed and other terms and conditions can be fixed by the institution subjected to the quantity of the work involved.

#### 2. UG/PG projects

UG/PG projects, for the purchase of consumables and minor fabrication, a maximum of Rs 10,000/- per project is permitted subjected to the availability of the corpus fund in the department.

#### 3. Support for Part Time Ph.D. work.

Since the availability of the fund is limited, fees charged for course work, registration fee etc. are not permitted using four funds.

#### 4. Remedial classes

Remedial classes can be arranged for weak students; however, remuneration is restricted to external and adhoc faculty members.

#### 5. Maintenance charge

The 30KVA UPS installed in the Applied Electronics block and purchased under the TEQIP Phase II package No TEQIP/KL/KL1GO2/62 is not working now. The Governing body permitted to repair the UPS using maintenance fund. The approximate expenditure is Rs. 72500/- as per agenda notes.

#### 6. The support to Professional body membership to faculty

The governing body permitted to support the Professional body membership to faculty @ of half the membership fee.

# 7. National Conference on Emerging Trends in Engineering in March 2017

The governing body requested the SPFU to conduct the conferences for a specific area in an institution with the participation of all TEQIP II institutions in the state.
