- 1) Whether presenters affiliated with institutions outside Kerala are permitted to participate only in the online mode, or if they also have the option to attend and present in-person (offline mode)?

All authors of accepted papers can attend the conference in person (offline mode), but presenters from KERALA cannot opt for online mode.

- 2) In the case of online participation, could you please confirm whether attendees will have full access to all seminars and sessions in the online mode that they would otherwise be able to attend in-person (offline mode)?

Attendees of online mode can have access only to the online session which they are presenting and to online keynote talks (limited number).

- 3) If out-of-state presenters are allowed to participate in the offline mode, I would like to know whether the organizing committee will be providing accommodation within the college premises

The organizing committee will be able to provide the details of the accommodation facility available nearer to the conference venue, which you can book.

- 4) Whether assistance will be provided in arranging nearby accommodation, or if the college could recommend trusted lodging options close to the venue, as participants may not be familiar with the locality?

Yes. Can assist in pointing out nearby accommodation facility, whose details will be available in the website.

- 5) Whether a paper submitted with multiple authors can be presented by more than one author during the conference, either in the online mode or the offline mode.

- 6) In case of Online presentation, Is it mandatory that all presenters appear together in a single video frame while recording the presentation, or would it be acceptable if each presenter records their respective parts separately and the videos are later merged into one complete presentation video before submission to the conference portal?

It is comfortable if the single author is appearing in the video recording for online presentation, which is a standard way in all conferences. In case if all the authors needs to appear, then it is also acceptable but cumbersome.

But in the actual session in online mode, when the video is presenting, all authors are to be available with camera ON in the meeting.

- 7) If the co-authors register as participants (and not presenters), will they still be able to attend the same online session during which their paper is presented?

Only one of the author need to be registered and all authors need to participate in the online session

- 8) In the above case, are they required to keep their video on during the session, and will they be acknowledged as part of the team during or after the presentation?

They need to be present and keep their video on during the session.

- 9) Will all registered authors (presenters or participants) receive the appropriate participation or presentation certificates accordingly?

Paper presentation certificate will include all authors while mentioning the author who presented the paper

- 10) For papers with multiple authors, will all registered presenters be allowed to attend the live online session during which the recorded presentation is played, even if only one appears in the video? Also, will presenters who are not featured in the recording still receive presenter certificates or acknowledgements?

Yes, all co-authors will be allowed to attend the live session even if only one appears in the video. The non-presenting co-author will receive the participation certificate and presentation certificate will be provided only to the author who is presenting the video.

- 11) In both online and offline modes, is it permissible for more than one author to jointly present the paper? If so, does this align with conference norms, and could it affect how the presentation is received or evaluated?

In offline mode, it is possible. But in online mode, it is comfortable one author to present, but not mandatory.

- 12) If co-authors register as participants rather than presenters, may they still attend the same session during which their paper is presented? In that case, are they expected to keep their video on, and will they be acknowledged as part of the author team during or after the presentation?

Yes. Co-authors have to be present throughout the online session and must respond to the question-and-answer session from the session chair.

- 13) Will all registered authors – whether as presenters or participants – receive the corresponding presentation or participation certificates?

The presented author will get the presentation certificate and the other participants will get the participation certificate.

- 14) I would also be grateful if you could kindly provide further details on how the online mode of the conference will be conducted. Specifically, could you please indicate the platform to be used (e.g., Zoom, Google Meet, etc.), whether live interaction with session chairs or attendees will be facilitated after presentations, and if presenters are expected to remain present for the entire session or only during their designated time slot?

The online session will be conducted via the Google Meet platform, during which your pre-recorded presentation video will be played. At the end of the session, there will be a question-and-answer interaction with the session chair. All authors are required to be present for this discussion.

- 15) If the first author presents offline and the co-authors participate online, is there any provision for the online co-authors to watch the presentation live and take part in the Q&A session? If a hybrid option is not available, what arrangements will be made for them, and will they still receive the participant certificate in that case?

There will be only recording of the offline session and live streaming will not be available. In offline session, presentation certificate will be provided only to the presenting author.

- 16) If one author presents offline and the remaining co-authors join online, should those co-authors register as participants or presenters? Also, will they receive certificates if they register as participants?

There is no option for mixing offline and online sessions. Clearly offline is an in-person mode activity fully and online sessions are completely online and no in-person activity is there.

- 17) If any registered co-author is unable to attend the session due to unavoidable reasons, will they still be eligible to receive the certificate, or is attendance mandatory?

The, participation certificate will be provided only to participating authors.

- 18) If only one author registers as the presenter and the other co-authors do not register, will those unregistered co-authors still receive any certificate acknowledging their authorship, or is registration as a participant required?

In case of online sessions, we will provide participation certificate for all co-authors attending online and not required to register. While this is not applicable for offline participants.
